If you are considering new windows and doors then these should be to PAS24 – 2016 standard. See this web page, under 'search approved products':

For additional security, install laminated glass, meeting the requirements of BS EN 356:2000 class 1A, should to be installed on ground floor and easily accessible windows. (See additional advice in response to a recent series of burglaries in the area below)

Locks

If you have 'Euro style' door locks, we recommend you consider upgrading the cylinder to TS007 3* (three star) standard, using a listed locksmith, from the Master Locksmiths Association. <http://www.locksmiths.co.uk/>
